Camp Achieve will provide safeguards of a trained medical staff, a low counselor to camper ratio and all staff trained in seizure recognition/first aid.

Registration

The cost for campers is \$300. The cost includes food, lodging, all activities, and a camp tee shirt. Each camper is responsible for transportation to and from the camp.

Scholarships are available to those who meet financial eligibility guidelines. Please request a scholarship application when sending in your registration form.

Camper Application Process:

- Send completed *Camper Registration Form* with a \$25 registration fee.*
- An application form will be mailed to you.
- Return completed application & fee by **July 11**.
- A neurology form will be sent to your neurologist and returned directly to EFEPA.
- A medical review committee will review all returned camper forms.
- A decision will be made as to whether Camp Achieve is a good fit for your child.
- There will be a **mandatory meeting** for ALL parents/guardians of accepted campers approximately 2 weeks before Camp Achieve.
