We utilize a system called CampDoc. Here are a few tips to help you with the application process:

- If you applied in 2016, CONGRATULATIONS! A profile already exists for you! Log into <a href="mailto:app.campdoc.com/register/efep">app.campdoc.com/register/efep</a> with the same email you used in 2016. If you did not save your password, you can reset it using the "Forgot your password" link. If you are not sure what email address you used, please contact us (<a href="mailto:camp@efepa.org">camp@efepa.org</a>, 215-629-5003) or the CampDoc support line via <a href="mailto:734.636.1000">734.636.1000</a> or help@campdoc.com.
- Register for the Camp Achieve Counselor session to get started. Many of the questions now only require you to review and approve your answers from 2016. You will need to reenter some parts of the application. Please ensure that all information is up-to-date to allow for accurate review for Camp Achieve 2017.
- If you are a NEW COUNSELOR, you will be creating a profile on CampDoc.com. This profile will house your application and important medical information needed for Camp Achieve. You are able to save your application if you need to take a break. All information entered is confidential. Please be sure to save your password!
- Add <u>notifications@campdoc.com</u> to your email contacts or to the "safe senders list" for your email browser. There will be
  periodic communications from this email address related to the status of your application.
- Once you register for the appropriate session (Camp Achieve Counselor), you will have access to the Health Profile section
  of your application. No applicant can be considered until this information is complete. To facilitate our timely review of your
  application, please have all information entered no later than May 15, 2017.
